Did you know...?

- You can no longer marry a non-European without permission from the Home Secretary, Charles Clarke.
 - There are new laws being piloted in Manchester, which will take away benefits from families whose asylum claims have been unsuccessful, meaning taking their children into care.
 - Right now in Manchester, because of immigration laws: Pregnant women married to British men are deported and then refused permission to re-enter the country;
- Fathers married to British women who have started a family together in England, live in constant fear of deportation.

These are all real cases...These laws contravene the Right to Family Life enshrined in the Human Rights Act and also the Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Shouldn't people be allowed to choose who they fall in love with, wherever they come from, without permission from the government?
